



General conditions of use of the Willy Favre Olympic Piste

General

- Privileged use of the piste is only possible if a reservation has been made using the form provided on the official Diablerets Alpine Centre website.
- Access to the piste is by Meillerets-Express gondola only, leaving at the intermediate station.
- The slope is part of the Diablerets-Villars-Gryon ski area, so TVGD (Télé-Villars-Gryon-Diablerets SA) lift company has sole authority to decide whether to close the gondola, and therefore the slope, for weather or technical reasons.

Safety and social interaction

- The piste is part of the Diablerets-Villars-Gryon ski area, so the ski area's safety rules apply. Exceptions to the TVGD rules, particularly with regard to speed, are tolerated during training or competitions. However, outside the training or competition zone, it is essential to respect the rules of the ski area.
- Outside the competition or training area, respect for other users is necessary. If TVGD representatives observe any inappropriate behaviour, they are empowered to withdraw the offender's ski pass for as long as they deem necessary.
- Users of the Willy Favre Olympic Piste have priority only on that piste. No passes or waivers will be granted at the departure of the gondola.
- Any piste user arriving at the gondola without a ski pass will be refused access to the gondola. It is the responsibility of everyone, including athletes, to have their ski pass.
- It is the responsibility of the users of the piste to ensure that the barrier tape delimiting the training area is in place before starting to set their course..

Bookings, cancellations and changes

- Only bookings made using the form on the official DAC website will be taken into account.
- A booking may be cancelled or moved free of charge up to 48 hours in advance. After this time, 75% of the value of the booking will be charged.
- In the event of cancellation for external reasons (e.g. premature closure of the facilities due to bad weather), no charge will be made.
- In the event of a double request to use the track, the oldest bookings have priority. However, in the event of a change in the external schedule (e.g. FIS races, Swiss-Ski, etc.), negotiations may be requested to move an event. In this case, the DAC will handle the discussion.

Invoicing, payments and passes

- Use of the piste is invoiced monthly.
- Extras will be invoiced at the end of the season.
- The invoice will be sent to the person who made the booking. If the billing address is different, the information must be sent to contact@diableretsalpinecentre.ch before the piste is used.
- Users in need of passes need to contact both info@tvgd.ch and caisse@tvgd.ch (mentioning DAC and the date of use of the piste in the subject) at least 48 hours before their reservation to announce how many passes are needed. They will have a preferential price. They are responsible for getting the passes at the start of the gondola and paying them directly to TVGD. If they cannot get the passes during the gondola's regular opening hours, they must specify this in their email when asking for passes so that an agreement can be found.

Confidentiality and data protection

- The name of the entity having made the reservation (person, team, company, etc) will be entered on the public schedule for use of the piste.
- Piste users' contact details will only be passed on to third parties with the prior agreement of the said users.

Responsibilities

- By ticking the box 'I have read the general conditions of use of the piste and I approve them', the piste user becomes responsible for the correct application of these conditions when using the piste. If you are not alone on the piste, it is your responsibility to inform the other users.
